Evaluation Criteria

1	Does the proposed project align with one or more of the priority sectors? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - How well does the project address gaps and potential impact within their field?
2	Does the application make a case for the novelty of the proposed research? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Does the application demonstrate significant scientific merit? - Is the proposed project tied to a well-articulated issue or problem facing New Brunswickers?
3	Does the application explain the readiness of the proposed work? I.e. are there milestones/timelines described in the application? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Partners in place with signed agreements or letters of support? - A breakdown of the project team and if there is significant work being conducted outside of NB, explain the role that plays in the success of this project.
4	Does the application fully explain how the work will be sustained going forward or how their work will be translated to relevant external knowledge users? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fully explain the quality and breadth of partnerships (across institutions and sectors)? - Are knowledge users clearly identified and is there a well-defined knowledge mobilization plan in place?
