Evaluation Criteria

1	<p>Does the proposed project align with one or more of the priority sectors?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - How well does the project address gaps and potential impact within their field?
2	<p>What will be achieved (i.e. additional data collection) with this funding that will help strengthen your application for reapplying to tri-council funding programs?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What steps will you take to demonstrate the progress of your work to improve your chances of success in applying for national agencies funding?
3	<p>Have the principal investigator and their collaborators demonstrated capacity to execute the project – in terms of the following?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Infrastructure and Equipment (lab space and capacity, industrial partnerships). - Personnel (both directly in the PI's team and the collaborators engaged, be they primary researchers, post-docs or students). - Support from the PIs institution (course release, direct funding, support for students, letters of support). - The principal investigator and their collaborators in the project have good standing within their specific field of study.
